

Dear Residents and Families,

The winter holidays we love so much are almost here, so we at Thrive are getting in the spirit to bring even more cheer. Whether your menorah is set or you're awaiting Santa's sleigh, we want you to know our communities are doing everything to be sure our residents are ready for the holiday! We hope to be together to celebrate in joy and festivities, but please know as always - our residents and team are our top priorities. Before we finish decking the halls, we have lots of details to share with you all!

For our community merriments, we will be hosting plenty of jolly jingles and festive feastings to celebrate the season. As always, we will be following the CDC, county, and state guidelines. Although we are going to make our communities feel especially like "home for the holidays," we are doing our part to ensure all residents may leave the community to celebrate with their families if they choose to do so. If a resident does leave the community, they must adhere to an in-suite retreat period upon their return until COVID-negative status is confirmed. As with Thanksgiving, we will be testing all residents and team members after the holidays. Additional information regarding the timing of the testing will be shared at a later date. As things are constantly evolving regarding state and county regulations, we will keep you posted on any changes or updates to our current course of action.

We also wanted to provide information on the COVID-19 vaccine. As part of the Phase 1a allocation, our CVS Health/Omnicare partners will be holding vaccine clinics at our communities for the Assisted Living and Memory Care residents, as well as team members. We are currently waiting on additional information based on the approval of the vaccine and the scheduling of the clinics through CVS Health/Omnicare. We will share updates as they become available.

Until then, we continue to do our part at our communities and follow our daily COVID-19 responsible approach to keep our residents healthy and safe including screening all team members prior to the start of their shift (if a team member shows any COVID-19 related symptoms, they are sent home to self-quarantine); screening residents for COVID-19 related symptoms; team members wearing masks at all times; enhanced cleaning throughout the community; and curbside cleaning of all packages/furniture before coming inside. If there is any known-exposure to COVID-19 in the community or we have an individual who tests positive for COVID-19, we will take steps to test all residents and team members as soon as possible and notify families.
